

NOTICE TO USERS OF THE CITY OF PRINCETON WATERWORKS

Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of Princeton, Indiana has introduced an Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 2004-6, to cause the Princeton Waterworks to be removed from the jurisdiction of the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission for approval of rates and charges and of the issuance of stocks, bonds, notes, or other evidence of indebtedness. Notice is further given that the final consideration of said Ordinance will be taken by the Common Council of the City of Princeton, Indiana at its regular meeting scheduled August 2, 2004 at 7:00 p.m. at the Council Chambers, Princeton Municipal Building, 310 West State Street, Princeton, Indiana.

All interested persons will have opportunity to be heard at said public hearing. If the Ordinance is adopted on August 2, 2004, the same will take effect sixty (60) days after its adoption unless there is submitted to the City of Princeton within sixty (60) days from adoption of the Ordinance a Petition signed by the number of voters within the City of Princeton equal to two percent (2%) of the total vote cast at the last election for Secretary of State requesting the Common Council to submit the question of removal from the IURC jurisdiction to the registered voters of the City of Princeton at the next election. If such a Petition is received, the Common Council of the City of Princeton, Indiana will submit the matter to the registered voters of the City of Princeton at the next available election.
